For commercial uses, the Applicant agrees to engage the services of a professional engineer to prepare a site plan for this connection, in accordance with the applicable sections of Vermont Environmental Protection Rules – Chapter 1, Appendix 1-7E and 1A, and to submit a site plan and attached Schedule C to the Wastewater Management Division of the DEC and Town of Stowe prior to final approval.

The installation of a water meter with an outside reader is required in order to measure water use. The meter will be furnished to the applicant upon payment of water and/or sewer connection fees. Facilities without water meters and remote meters shall be charged based on the flow rating of the connection as indicated above.

In general a water curb stop and/or sewer line stub is provided by the Town to the edge of the road right-of-way for each existing property. It is the responsibility of the property owner/applicant to continue the service.

Sewer Requirements

- Grease traps are mandatory on the kitchen waste flow from all commercial facilities.
- Existing septic tanks shall be cleaned by a licensed sludge hauler and removed to an approved disposal site or filled completely with clean bank gravel and left in place.
- A direct connection to a manhole, or the construction of a control manhole is required when flows exceed 1000 gpd or two or more buildings are using the same connection.
- Minimum connection shall be 6-inch diameter cast iron or SDR-35 pipe.

\* The flow rating for all residential uses shall be 150 gpd per bedroom.

Water Requirements

- The installation of an expansion tank and check valve is mandatory for all connections.
- Applicant shall seek the advice of a licensed plumber regarding the need for a pressure-reducing valve.
- Minimum residential connection shall be 1-inch diameter ASTM B-88 copper or AWWA C-901 polyethylene pipe compatible with bronze compression fittings.

Connection Fees

Connections to the water/sewer systems will not be permitted until the connection has received approval of the Water and/or Sewer Commission and the connection fees have been paid. Sewer connection fees may be paid over an extended period, with a 10% down payment. A lien in favor of the Town of Stowe will be filed on the property and must be executed before the connection is made. A Connection Permit will be issued upon receipt of applicable fees and liens.

The owner and applicant agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the sewer and water departments, and furthermore agree to pay the Town of Stowe, upon invoice, access fees and for water and sewer use based on metered amounts, and such other expenses as may be allowed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Stowe Water Department and Sewer Department. The applicant and owner hereby acknowledge receipt of the current water and sewer fee schedules.
