Dear Mr. Prevost:

In previous years, the Stowe Selectboard has received permission from your department to grant blanket approval to 1st, 2nd and 3rd class and outside consumption liquor license applications for the ensuing year.

Unless otherwise stipulated by the Department of Liquor and Lottery, the following procedure has been used at Board meetings:

- 1.) The Selectboard is given a list of all applicants along with copies of applications;
- 2.) The Selectboard is asked if they have any concerns with any applicant on the list, and, if so, those are discussed and voted on separately;
- 3.) All other applications would be recommended for approval in one motion; and
- 4.) The Town Clerk would affix a label to each application noting approval by the Selectboard acting as the Board of Liquor Control Commissioners and the date of the warned meeting.

I am requesting that the Town of Stowe be granted permission once again to utilize the procedure outlined above.
