**Stowe Energy Committee**

The Stowe Selectboard is currently accepting letters of interest from Stowe High School students interested in serving on the Stowe Energy Committee. The SEC makes recommendations to the Selectboard, the Planning Commission, and the Town Manager regarding Town policy on energy-related matters.

The Committee identifies opportunities and makes recommendations to the appropriate Town officials and committees regarding energy conservation and efficiency, non-fossil energy sources and pollution and reduction that address the environmental and fiscal benefits to the Town government, residents and businesses.

The Committee educates the citizens and property owners of the Town about energy conservation, alternative energy sources and other sustainability measures, and increases public awareness of energy issues and builds public support for energy efficiency and sustainable energy policies.

The student appointment will run from August 1, 2024 - July 31, 2025. The student is expected to attend monthly meetings of the Committee and develop a workplan in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair.
