The legal voters of the Stowe School District are hereby notified that the **Annual Meeting** scheduled for Tuesday, March 5, 2024, at 8:00 a.m. in the Auditorium at Stowe High School, with voting from the floor on Articles 3-7, has been **canceled**. Additionally, the Board of School Directors **public informational hearing** scheduled for Wednesday, February 28, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. in the Music Room at Stowe Elementary School to discuss Article 2 has also been **canceled**.

The legal voters of the Stowe School District are hereby notified that the Articles warned for voting on March 5, 2024 by **Australian Ballot** have been **canceled**.

The District's Annual Meeting and Australian Ballot vote will be held on March 15, 2024. The District's **public informational hearing will be scheduled for Tuesday, March 5, at 8:00 a.m. in the Stowe High School gymnasium.**

ARTICLE 1: To elect School Directors of the Stowe School District:

- a. One for a term of three (3) years
- b. One for a term of three (3) years

ARTICLE 2: Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend \$17,233,823, which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year?

The legal voters of the Stowe School District are further notified that voter qualification, registration, and absentee voting relative to said annual meeting shall be provided in Chapters 43, 51, and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

ARTICLE 3: To elect a Moderator for the Annual Meeting.

ARTICLE 4: Shall the voters of the Stowe School District vote to act upon the reports of the schools as presented?


ARTICLE 5: Shall the voters of the Stowe School District authorize the School Directors to borrow money to pay current expenses and debts of said District in anticipation of the collection of taxes for such purposes and returns from the State, and, if so, provide that the same be done by notes of the District?

ARTICLE 6: Shall the voters of the Stowe School District authorize the School Directors to apply six hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$670,000) of the school district's fund balance as revenue for the 2024-2025 school year budget?


ARTICLE 7: To do any other business that may legally come before the Stowe School District meeting.


