## INSTRUCTIONS

Please complete all pages in the OFFICIAL RETURN OF VOTES. You will use the ORV to enter in your Election Night Results and to submit the ORV in VEMS the next day.

### WRITE-INS

1. You do not need to report the names of deceased or fictitious people (ex. Abe Lincoln or (Mickey Mouse).
2. Deceased or Fictitious write-in names should be reported as Blank Votes.
3. Remember in VT, a write-in candidate is reported even if the OVAL is NOT FILLED IN.
4. Write-In ovals that are filled in with no name written are reported as Blank Votes.
5. A write-in vote for a candidate listed on the ballot is a vote for that candidate.

### TOTAL VOTES COUNTED WHERE VOTE FOR NOT MORE THAN 2, 3, OR 6:

For any race where there is a "Vote for NOT MORE THAN" that is greater than 1 you must multiply the # of ballots counted by the Vote for Not More Than NUMBER. (For example, if you have a senate race with a Vote for Not More Than 3 and you had 496 ballots counted, you must multiply  $496 \times 3 = 1488$  TOTAL VOTES COUNTED for that race.)

If a voter votes for more candidates than the "vote for not more than" number, enter overvotes in the overvote line equal to the "vote for not more than" number. (For example, if a voter votes for 3 candidates in a race where they were supposed to vote for not more than 2, enter 2 overvotes in the overvote line.)
